An introduction to DARVVEN TOVNCENTRE





Darwen is a Lancashire market town and former textile mill town, nestled between a dramatic moorland valley, yet just 40 minutes from Manchester by direct train. The town gets its name from the River Darwen, which flows under the town centre and can be spotted in Shorey Bank Park. Today, Darwen Town Centre is a vibrant place to visit with independent shops, bars and restaurants, and a friendly, down-to-earth vibe.

Darwen Market Square is the central point in the town centre, and is where the majority of events take place. The square was extensively redeveloped in 2018 and 2019, and is now home to The Weaver Bird, a tribute to Darwen's major role in the North West's textile industry. The Weaver Bird is inspired by the peregrine falcons that nest in the iconic India Mill Chimney to the South of the town centre, and is made from woven sheet metal by artist, Liam Hopkins.

The market square is also home to Darwen Market Hall, an impressive Victorian building, opened in 1882. Today, the market has a wide array of stalls, selling everything from homemade cakes and pies, to household goods.

In this guide, we will be taking you through Darwen Town Centre's main areas (chiefly Bolton Road, Bridge Street, Croft Street, Railway Road, Market Street and Duckworth Street), to give you a taste of what Darwen has to offer visitors. For a fairly small town, we think you'll be pleasantly surprised by the amount of places to visit, shop, eat and drink the night away. We'll also give you an overview of local green spaces to explore, and family things to do.

DELI CARLO : FOR A LUNCHTIME TREAT Croft street

Akash and Anaz are two of Darwen's most popular and longstanding Indian restaurants. Akash opened in 1983, and Anaz in 1981. Both restaurants serve fresh, authentic Indian dishes to delight your tastebuds.

The Bank Bar & Kitchen is a stylish, newly renovated venue serving everything from high quality breakfasts, and tasty burgers, to cocktails and refreshing lagers. They regularly have entertainment on weekend evenings, and even offer "Bottomless Brunch".

FREEDOM ORGANICS: FOR ORGANIC VEGAN FOOD DUCKWORTH STREET

Freedom Organics is an organic, vegan, wholefoods café serving innovative fresh food in a chilled environment. The menu changes regularly, depending on what is in season, but is always popular with vegans and non-vegans alike.

CIN CIN: FOR EVENING COCKTAILS Church bank street

Cin Cin is a modern bar specialising in cocktails and gin. A very popular weekend spot, Cin Cin is open late Thursday - Saturday, and does regular deals on cocktails. If you're planning a night out in Darwen, make sure it's on your list.

SPITFIRE SPORTS BAR: FOR SPORTS LOVERS BOROUGH ROAD

The Spitfire is a lively sports bar with multiple TV screens, plus pool/snooker tables and darts boards. They serve Eddie's authentic woodfired pizza, so you can enjoy a bite to eat with your drinks. Make sure you check out their downstairs neighbour, The Vault, too.

Darwen Library Theatre is an arts centre that aims to host a quality and diverse programme of theatre, film, comedy, literature and music in an intimate setting.

DARWEN HERITAGE CENTRE Railway Road, 01254 433140

Darwen Heritage Centre is a fantastic free resource for everyone. It is located within the handsome Holker House on Railway Road, in a prime position between Darwen Market Square and St Peter's Church. It's valuable for anyone who wants to find out more about Darwen's past and understand the industrial history that wove the threads that make the Darwen of today.

BOLD VENTURE PARK Manor Road

Bold Venture Park opened in 1889 and is both a historic and picturesque park. Lying in the valley of Bold Venture Brook, it acts as a bridge connecting Darwen town to the countryside of Darwen Tower, Jubilee Tower and beyond.

DARWEN TOWER

A highly noticeable and iconic, local landmark, Darwen Jubilee Tower stands proudly on Darwen Hill, in the midst of the West Pennine Moors by Sunnyhurst woods. Restoration work is currently being undertaken on the tower and access is currently off-limits until the work is done. The improvements will ensure that the tower's lifespan increases, and that it will continue to be enjoyed by many future generations.

SUNNYHURST WOOD OFF EARNSDALE ROAD

Sunnyhurst Wood is a 85 acre wooded valley, with seven miles of footpaths leading onto Darwen moor up to Darwen Tower. Sunnyhurst Brook flows through the wood. Attractions include a visitor centre and a series of wooden animal sculptures.

DARWEN TOWER WALKS

Walk 1: Approaching from Darwen town centre, this route takes you through the calm, picturesque Bold Venture Park, before the steep ascent to the iconic landmark of the West Pennine Moors. This is a 2 mile walk with a steep ascent and decent, it takes approximately 1.5 hours.

Walk 2: Starting at Sunnyhurst Wood, this circular 2 mile walk takes in some fantastic views of the surrounding countryside from Darwen Moors. There is one, short, steep ascent and it takes approximately 1.5 hour in total. W: www.visitblackburn.co.uk/outdoors/walking
